Prior to Parade:

- The Parade Committee's decision regarding all entrants is final. The Committee will not approve entries depicting political or social issues of controversial nature.
- **Parade Check in / Line up starts at 8am.** Location to be announced. Check in closes at 10am. - Late arrivals parade line up location subject to change or denied entry.
- Upon Check in, participants will be directed to their line up position and given their entry number papers. The Entry Numbers should be placed on the front **LEFT** side of your lead vehicle, float, banner, flag, etc. and on the back of the last vehicle, float, etc. in order for the Judges and the Emcee to identify your entry.
- **The Driver must stay with their float and a contact number has to be given to the Parade Committee at check-in if not already submitted, as well as have a Valid Drivers License available upon request.**
- **Entrants must be in place by 10:15am for judging.** Judging will take place without announcement.
- If you win an award, you will be notified prior to the start of the parade. Your winning Rosette must be displayed on the Front Left side of your entry, next to your entry number.
- The RCMP requires that you ensure the brakes on all vehicles and bikes are in proper working order. All motorized vehicles must be licensed and insured to operate. All vehicle floats, animal entries, must have insurance for bodily injury and property damage with combined single limits of at least \$2 Million. You also must have a working and in good order Fire Extinguisher (dry chemical/ 51BS) carried on each float.
- Parade starts at 11am - Engine start time at 10:45am



During the Parade:

- All groups may make only **ONE** stop along the route for 2-Minutes in front of City Hall. Please do not stop anywhere else along the route.
- Do not bunch up. Keep approximately 40-50ft (2-4 car lengths) between entries.
- **Do not throw anything along the Parade Route.** Should you wish to distribute candy or any other items please have a participant from your entry walk alongside the edge of the route and hand out directly to the crowd.
- All animal entries must have a decorated clean-up unit following it.
- Alcohol beverages and other incapacitating substances are forbidden on any vehicle, float, entry or person. Consuming substances during the parade is cause for immediate ejection from the event.
- There will be a designated location upon exiting the Parade, if you need to stop and make your vehicle road worthy.
 - This will be a quick stop and should not take more than a couple minutes. Please have a plan in place.
- Any and all clean up necessary in regards to your entry will be the responsibility of the entry.
